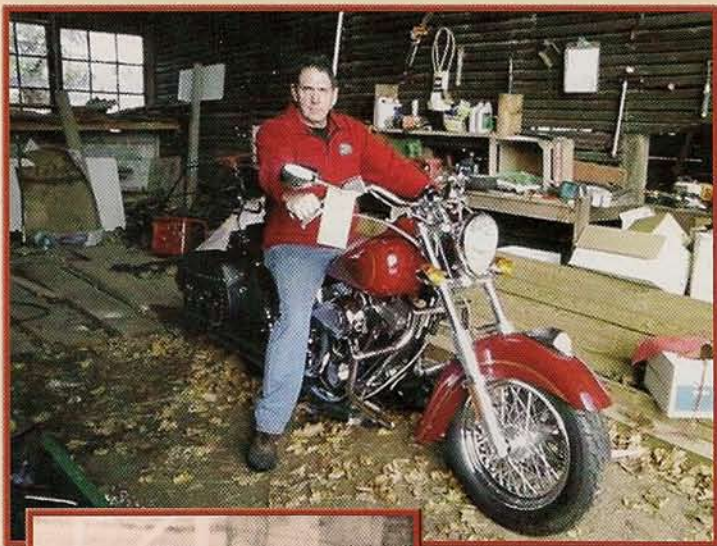


# good vibrations
